IMPORTANT RULES TO BE FOLLOWED BY THE STUDENTS

REGULATIONS FOR SEMESTER SYSTEM

Maximum duration for Passing the entire course:

• The candidate shall pass the degree within double the duration of the course

Break-up of the marks for theory and practical papers:

- For papers having practicals in general, for I to IV Semesters, the break-up of marks is 70+30, out of which 70 Marks are for theory and 30 marks are for practicals. Out of 70 marks, 60 marks are for theory and 10 marks are for IA. Out of the 30 Marks for practicals, 20 marks are for practicals and 10 marks are for IA/Practical record. Preparation of practical record is compulsory. For practicals in V and VI Semester, marks shall be 100, out of which 80 marks are for practicals in each semester examination, 20 marks are for IA and the practical record.
- For papers without practical, break-up of marks is 80+20. 80 marks are for theory and 20 marks are for I.A., respectively.
- Periodical tests/ assignment/ seminars/viva voce will be conducted for internal assessment.

Classification of successful candidates:

- The candidate shall take examinations in both theory and practical together.
- Minimum for a pass in each paper (theory and practical put together) shall be 40% provided minimum for pass in theory component shall be 30%. For a paper without practical component, minimum for pass shall be 40%.

*The break-up marks may vary as per the course and subjects.

### ATTENDANCE

Record of attendance will be maintained by the taking of attendance at the beginning of each hour. Each student should put in the required attendance for the semester, by attending not less than 75% of the number of working hours/periods in each paper/subject in each semester. 80% of Value Education class attendance is compulsory.

Students must produce leave letters, explaining their absence from class. Leave letters must be addressed to the Principal and countersigned by the parent/guardian/warden. The leave letters must be signed by all the subject teachers. However, attendance cannot be claimed for absence.

75% attendance in all subjects is mandatory to appear for the University Semester Examination failing which hall ticket will not be issued.

### CERTIFICATES

- No certificate shall be granted unless a student has maintained the attendance, prescribed by the college/ university in the course of instruction, followed by her during the year and progress and conduct have been satisfactory, neither will a certificate be issued unless all dues to the college are paid.
- 2. Students applying for a transfer, conduct and course certificate will be issued the same on payment of the required fee.
- Every application for a certificate shall be made at least three days before the certificate is required and shall contain all particulars regarding the student's name, identity card number, year of the examination passed and subjects taken. The fax/postal charges shall also be charged.



#### HOSTELS
