

#### 1. The Curriculum is relevant to my current job



#### 2. Course content is interesting



#### 3. The Course curriculum had fulfilled my expectations



#### 4. Awareness is provided on career option in the college



## 5. Academic flexibility in terms of course combination is offered in the college



# 6. Usage of information Communication Technology (ICT) for teaching and learning is effective



7. The curriculum helped my career enhancement



8. Awareness on issues relevant to professional ethics, gender, human values, environment and the sustainability as provided effective through syllabi



## 9. Curriculum that I have chosen helped me to enrich my life skill


