#### INITIATION AND FORMATION OF NCC AT TERESIAN COLLEGE

Teresian College NCC was being run as an OPEN UNIT and we had applied for a NCC wing at our Institution. On 6<sup>th</sup> June 2016 was given permission to start an Air Wing coy troop of 50 girl students (Senior Wing) and was also requested to appoint a Caretaker.

On 16<sup>th</sup> July 2016 Mrs. Mary Sangeetha was chosen to be the Caretaker and the same was sent to the Unit (4KAR AIR SQN NCC). After an interview at the Head Quarters at Mysuru on 30<sup>th</sup> July 2016 and at the State Head Quarters at Bangalore on 8<sup>th</sup> August 2016, She was appointed as Caretaker Of NCC at our Institution.

Our First Batch of Fourteen NCC Cadets were enrolled on 21st July 2016 after many rounds of interview.

#### COMMISSIONED AS FLYING OFFICER FOR THE AIR WING NCC, TERESIAN COLLEGE



Mrs. Mary Sangeetha, Assistant Professor of the Department of English, was commissioned as Flying Officer for NCC, Teresian College on 2nd December 2017, after a rigorous training of three months. The training was of two phases; Part I Pre-commission course was from 25th June 2017 to 17 July 2017 at Officer Training Academy, Gwalior and Part II Pre-commission course was from 3rd October 2017 to 2nd December 2017 at Air Force Station, Tambaram, Chennai. The course included physical activities and studies of personality development, importance of NCC in armed forces, basic flight engineering along with Aeromodelling and Aero-engines, to help me teach NCC cadets for their certificate examinations and to enforce them to be better citizens of India and motivate them to join the Armed Forces.

#### LEADERSHIP CAMP




#### FELICITATION OF SAHANA.P
