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## DEPARTMENT OF HISTORY

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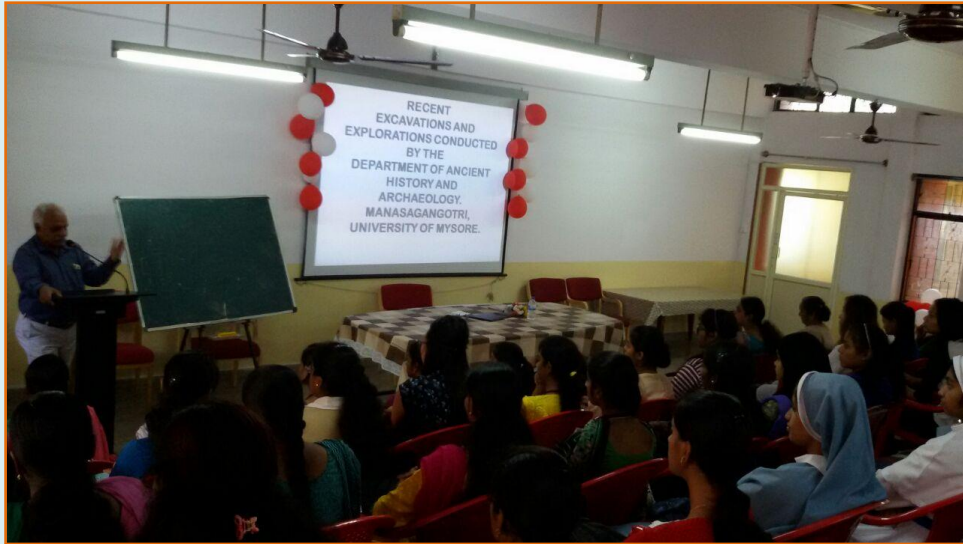
1. The Department of History had organised a candle light freedom march in the Teresian Campus on 14<sup>th</sup> August, 2016.

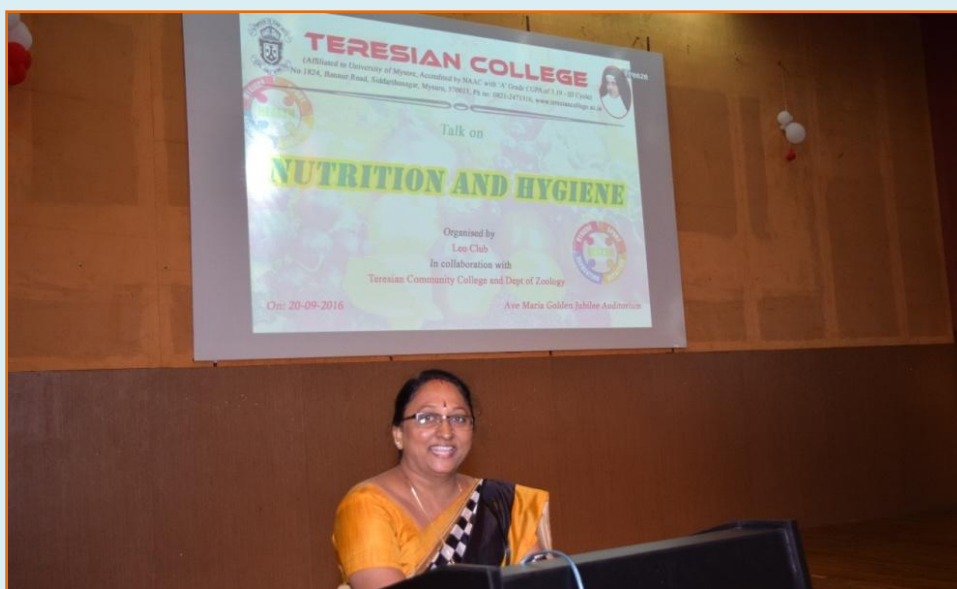


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## DEPARTMENT OF ZOOLOGY
