The Department of Hindi organised a Solo Singing competition on the occasion of Hindi Divas on 16<sup>th</sup> September, 2017.

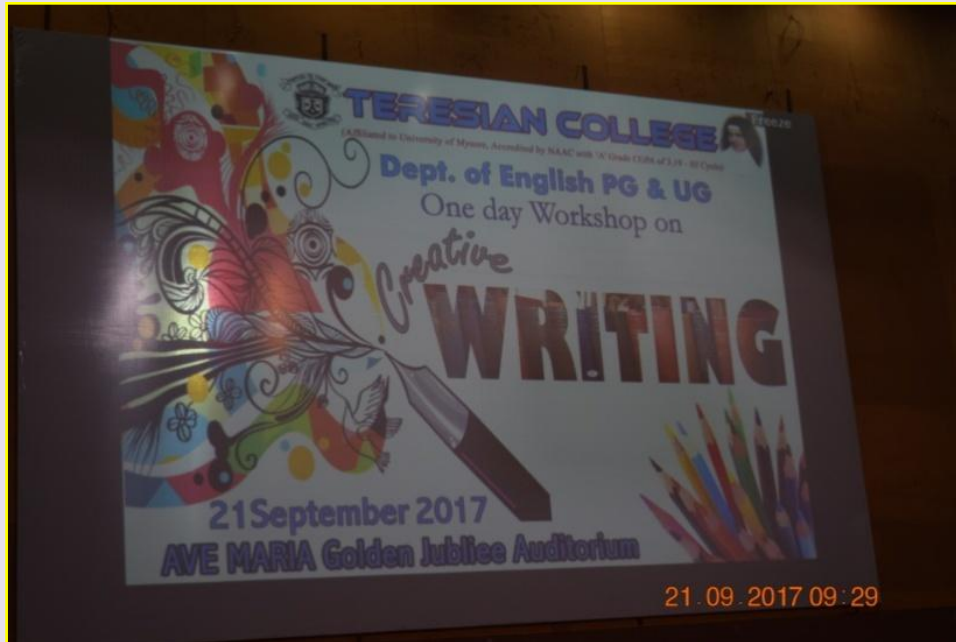
## SEMINAR ON MEDICINAL PLANTS OF THE WESTERN GHATS

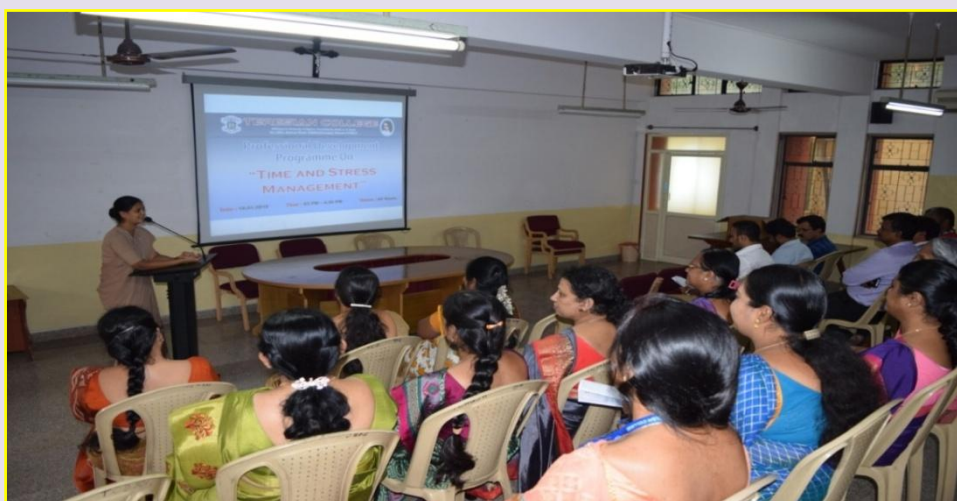
Fashion Designing students had Industrial visited to KSIC silk factory, and Mysore sandal factory on 01<sup>st</sup> March, 2018.
