Curriculum Development:

- Research centre to be expanded with recognition to other PG programs.
- Consultancy services offered has to be strengthened.
- Collaboration and linkages for internships, projects, and research have to be increased.
- Outreach and extension programmes to be expanded to more beneficiaries.
- Programmes/ activities have to be organised under MOU signed with industries and academic institutions.

Infrastructure and Learning Resources:

- The college infrastructure has to be upgraded with addition of classrooms and laboratories. The indoor stadium and women's hostel construction has to be completed.
- The number of ICT enabled and smart classrooms have to be increased.

- The library services have to be upgraded and automated.
- The extension counter of a bank to be opened in the campus.
