**7.2.1. Best Practice 1**

Title of the best Practice:

**“Experiential learning approaches”**

**Objectives of the Practice:**

To provide holistic and comprehensive approach for education of students through experiential models of learning.

**The Context:**

Programmes to address the needs and challenges of the global market and to equip students with real-world experience. Experiential learning bridges between the academic knowledge and industrial skills required.

**The Practice:**

All the departments have organized programmes such as internships, project works, industrial and field visits, certificate and value-added courses, life-skills, research writing, participation in curricular and co-curricular activities.

**Evidence of Success:**

The programmes have propelled the students towards academic excellence with overall pass percentage of 95.07% and 11 gold medals. 101 students progressed for higher studies and 14 students were recruited.

**Problems Encountered and Resources Required:**

The program's have not impacted performance of the slow-learners' as they required a diverse approach of remedial classes and peer-teaching methods.

Title of the best Practice:

**“Empowerment Programmes for Holistic Development of Villages”**

#### **Objectives of the Practice:**

To create awareness on basic tenets of knowledge regarding contemporary issues on social enhancement and empowerment for societal welfare.

#### **The Context:**

Programmes to address persistent challenges towards gender sensitization, cultural stereotypes, financial inclusiveness, health and hygiene prevalent in the villages were to be addressed to achieve holistic empowerment and development.

#### **The Practice:**


All the departments of the College have organized programmes in the villages at regular intervals. The villagers are given hands on experience and exposure to the theoretical ideas imparted. Radical issues were addressed through skit, dance, demonstration, talks etc. Health camps promoted safe, hygienic and healthy lifestyle choices.

#### **Evidence of Success:**

Eleven (11) extension and outreach programmes have been organised. The increase in the active participation of villagers in the programmes have displayed their change in approach and attitude.

#### **Problems Encountered and Resources Required:**
